


Rankings and Methodology

We surveyed 353 D1 colleges and universities between June 1, 2020 and May 31, 2021 on Instagram, Facebook, and Twitter. Using this data and a weighted formula, we generated an overall engagement ranking for each school **that blends total engagement and engagement rates**.

The top-ranked colleges and universities on social media have high engagement rates with average or better audience size and posting volumes.
